3 WHY NE-IAS

There is need to spread awareness about this lucrative career among youth in NE. Apart from lack of orientation, the training process also leaves much to be desired. As aspirants are not well informed about this stream, their preparation and dedication are not up to the mark. Besides, there is very little study material at the disposal of students. Coaching centres in NE have failed to build a strong network with nationally famous trainers and training centres. Whatever is done in this regard is for commercial gains only. Thus, a comprehensive approach is required in this regard so that a strong network could be established and good trainers, good training modules and expansive resource material may be organized both from within the states and outside.

Mission 100

The mission of NE-IAS is to create 100 civil servants from North Eastern States in next five years [2017-2021]. 4 WHAT DO WE OFFER?

NE-IAS is offering Civil Service Preparation Programme in Guwahati focusing on the forthcoming Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) and State Civil Service examinations. The objective of this programme is to develop a 'breed of new administrative leaders' in the North-East India, who could act as change -agents for transforming our North-Eastern region in social, economic and public administration fronts.

5 COURSE METHODOLOGY:

7 OUR COURSES:

Foundation Programme (FP) (Duration: One Day)

- This one-day programme aims at spotting the areas of strength as well as weakness of students at early stages of their preparation. The target group of FP is class 10th, 11th and 12th students. There is also test series in this course.

Advanced foundation Programme (AFP) (Duration: Two Days)

- This two days programme aim to give insights into IAS exam preparation by introducing students to structure of IAS exam and subjects therein as well as bringing clarity by eliminating myths in IAS exam preparation. The programme is linked to the selection test for civil service training programmes of NE-IAS.

Success Assured Programme (SAP) for Civil Service Prelims (Duration: Four Months)

- This is a fast-track and intensive class room programme focusing on sincere civil service aspirants. Our experts provide step by step guidance to aspirants for understanding the concepts of the subject and prepare them for effective answer writing, particularly, civil service prelimns. SAP will also make aspirants ready for civil service mains.

Integrated Success Assured Programme (I-SAP) for Civil Service Prelims and Mains (Duration: 10 Months)

- This is a complete and integrated package to prepare students for Civil Services Examination in 10 months' period. Foundation Programmes and Advanced Foundation Programmes are in pro-bono in nature with minimum fee for aptitude test and NE-IAS publications.

9 FELLOWSHIP

NE-IAS is announcing fellowship programmes to support youths for pursuing a career in civil services. These fellowship programmes will enable talented students of NE region in availing quality training and coaching in NE-IAS campuses. UPSC and APSC aspirants, who are domiciled in North East region, with excellent academic records, will be eligible for the NE-IAS fellowship programme. Only those candidates who will appear in the NE-IAS selection test will be eligible for the scheme.

9.1 CATEGORIES OF FELLOWSHIPS

NE-IAS offers three fulltime fellowships to the first three position holders in the NE-IAS selection test. The maximum amount of these fellowships will be of 120,000 INR per student. There are also partial scholarships available for applicants, who can secure minimum 60% in the selection test.

10 ADMISSION

NE-IAS invites applications from interested applicants for the current year batches. Applicants shall pass at least undergraduate with minimum 55 percent marks, along with a good academic records and leadership qualities. It is obligatory for the applicant to appear and qualify in an internal selection test to be eligible for taking admission in NE IAS. The age limits of applicant shall be in accordance to the guidelines of the UPSC and other relevant civil services.
